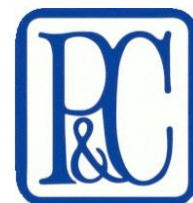
ABSENT, LATE OR EARLY? If your child is not at school, let us know they are safe. If we don't know, we will let you know they are not at school with a SMS message
