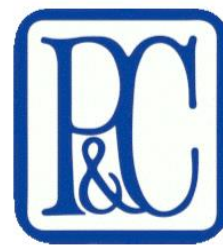

Uniform Shop and thank you Wendy and Caterina

One way the P&C supports the school community and families is by running the school uniform shop, so that you buy the uniform at the school without the need to travel to Ballina or Tweed and pay several dollars more per item because of the retail mark up.

We run the shop more so as a service to the school, rather than a revenue raiser for the P&C. The bit of revenue we do make goes back into supporting the school and students with resources and or experiences that aren't funded by other sources.

Therefore we hope that you will continue to support the uniform shop, even though we have made a decision at the last P&C meeting to increase each uniform item by about \$1.00 to \$2.00 from the 1st July. Our uniforms are still \$5 to \$9 cheaper than the prices of each piece of uniform for the other regional high schools.

We are really appreciative of all the upfront and behind the scenes work that two of our P&C members, Wendy Fisher and Caterina Barry, do to keep the uniform shop open and well stocked to meet the needs of our students and families.

This price increase will enable us to keep up with costs, it is not expected to increase any "profit" from the sale of uniforms.




